The Faculty of Russian philology, which has reach traditions of teaching, has accumulated extensive experience working with students from European and American universities. Faculty professors have prepared a number of programs:

- 8-weeks program, which involves 20-24-hours per week;
- 15-weeks (semester) program with 20-hours per week.

8-weeks program is designed for Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced. In accordance with each level we offer following modules:

- Grammar of Russian language
- Speech development
- Linguistic and regional studies of Russia
- Literary reading
- Phonetics and basic spelling of the Russian language
- Armenia: country and people









For students with basic and advanced levels (Intermediate high and Advanced), a 15-week semester program "Russian language in the professional sphere" is also offered, which includes the following aspects:

- Russian grammar
- Speech development
- Literary reading
- Geography of Russia
- Russian history
- Political science
- Armenia: country and people

Each group has 5 teachers. During the training period, students are provided with textbooks, teaching aids and additional materials.

The proposed integrated approach, the experience of our teachers, and the use of modern methods allow us to increase the language competence of students.
