The European Campus of City-Universities (EC2U) is a multi-cultural and multilingual Alliance consisting of eight long-standing, education- and research-led, locally and globally engaged universities from four diverse regions of the European Union: the University of Coimbra, the University of Iasi, the University of Jena, the University of Pavia, the University of Poitiers, the University of Salamanca, the University of Turku and the University of Linz.

The EC2U Virtual Institute for Quality Education (VIQE) is one of the Alliance's Virtual Institutes and combines education, research and innovation for advanced studies on quality education.

The University of Turku, Finland, in collaboration with its EC2U Partner Universities, invites submissions for the Young Researchers' Meeting in Turku, a three-day live event taking place from 1 to 3 April 2025.

Eligibility, Funding and Application

Eligibility

The University of Jena will select their candidates internally. Submissions should showcase innovative approaches, interdisciplinary insights, or emerging trends relevant to the theme mentioned above. Selected participants will be invited to present their work during the event. Candidates must hold a position as a doctoral researcher at the University of Jena. Researchers applying for mobilities must have a working knowledge of English, working knowledge of German and French will be an asset.

Funding: EC2U Grant

The EC2U grant covers mobility costs for up to three (3) doctoral researchers from the University of Jena. Notice that two travelling days are included (Monday 31 March and Friday 4 April 2025).

The EC2U Grant covers up to 1265,00 € [(4*126€) accommodation + (5*93€) subsistence + 296€ travel support].
